TOP TWO RISKS

There are plenty of safety risks in construction, but two stand out:

1 **FALLS** are the leading cause of death in the industry, accounting for one-third of on-the-job fatalities¹

PREVENTING FALLS

All daily maintenance on new Cat® Excavators can be performed from the ground. Pull the dipstick, check the coolant, inspect the fuel water separator, empty the fuel tank drains. No climbing necessary.

Dozens of other maintenance checks can also be done with both feet on the ground. Whether it's time to top off the wiper fluid, change a battery or refill the DEF tank, the work gets done quickly with less risk of falling.

2 **CONTACT WITH EQUIPMENT** is the primary cause of nonfatal injuries that result in days away from work¹

AVOIDING CONTACT WITH EQUIPMENT

Dig, lift, swing, dump—an excavator is always in motion. To reduce the risk of collision, we made E-fence technology standard on the Cat 320 and 323. It's a simple way to set electronic boundaries around a machine—above, below, front and sides. If a boundary is about to be breached, motion stops automatically, preventing damage to people, property and equipment.

Good visibility from the cab also helps prevent contact between people and assets. The new excavators feature large windows and a low front profile for a clear view of the work area. A standard rearview camera makes it easier to see behind the machine. And an optional 360° visibility feature provides even more perspective.
